



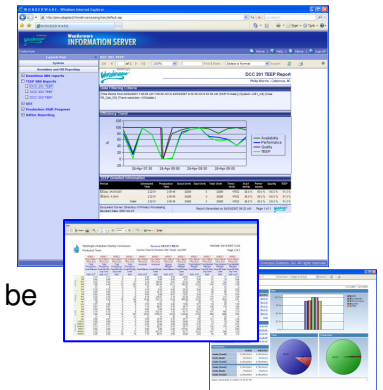

SRS Advanced for Administrators – 5 Day Training Class

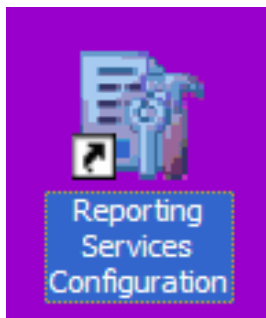
